109th Leicester Countesthorpe St Andrews Open Selection Process for Trustee Board Agreed by Trustee Board 24th March 2024. Next review due March 2025

- Nominations will open for people to express their interest or nominate others to join the Trustee Board with a cut-off date no less than 4 weeks prior to the AGM.
- Existing Trustees will need to express their interest in re-standing as trustees.
- Nominations for Chair will be made to the Group Lead Volunteer on jack.barber@countesthorpescouts.org.uk
- Nominations for all other Trustee positions, including Treasurer, will need to be made to the Chair on chair@countesthorpescouts.org.uk
- An Elections process, should it be required, will be held prior to the AGM, with the results published and ratified by the Group Scout Council at the AGM.
- All Group Scout Council members as of the closing date of nominations shall be eligible to vote. Elections shall be carried out by an appropriate form of secret ballot.
- This Elections process shall be ran by the Group Lead Volunteer and current Chair or other suitable Trustees should these roles be vacant. Should there be an Election required for the position of Chair, the Group Lead Volunteer should be supported by another suitable Trustee.
- Elections shall be independently observed by a member of a neighbouring Scout Group.
- Chair and Treasurer will be asked to take 3 year roles. (In 2024, the Treasurer will be elected for 2 years, to then allow this to be staggered. ie. the next Treasurer election will be due in 2026, next Chair election 2027.)
- All other nominated roles will be asked to take 1 year roles.
